BASE DATE FOR SHOWS: May 7th & 8th, 2022

SANCTION: Buck show is single sanctioned.

The AMERICAN DAIRY GOAT ASSOCIATION recognizes the Buck-A-Palooza Dairy Goat Show as an official show. ADGA rules shall govern. ASGBA general rules apply.

ENTRY FEES:

- ASGBA Members - \$10.00 per animal per ring or \$35.00 per animal if entered in all four rings. Non-members - \$15.00 per animal per ring or \$40.00 per animal if entered in all four rings. **No refunds.**

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Checks should be made payable to Arizona State Goat Breeders Association (ASGBA) or if using Paypal send to ASGBAGoats@gmail.com
- Entries postmarked after April 27th are subject to doubling unless per entry clerk request (i.e.: requesting more animals to sanction a breed).
- Check-In as follows: Friday afternoon 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.
Saturday/Sunday 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m.
- Add-ons and/or returned check fee(s) must be paid for at time of check-in.
- **DOGS** – Absolutely NO dogs will be allowed near the show rings. Dogs must be on a leash when not penned or kenneled.
- **Dress code:** Clean white shirt, clean long (below knee) white or black pants or skirt, closed toe shoes.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: Note: ADGA rules at time of show shall apply

If your animal is less than 6 months of age, a stamped duplicate is acceptable. Any animal over 6 months MUST have original registration papers. Animals must be entered under the "OWNED BY" name on the registration papers, not the name on a signed transfer paper. All animals must be checked in by Entry Clerk in order to show.

TATTOOS:

Chairman may choose to check any breed or age group for tattoos. If tattoos are not there or if they are illegible, ADGA will not award a Championship.

HEALTH RULES:

Arizona law requires that all animals be properly identified (tattooed) and listed on a self-inspection form. Arizona exhibitors may be required to present a self-inspection form or seasonal pass listing all animals to be shown upon check-in. No animal showing evidence of disease will be accepted and will be required to leave the grounds. Entry fees will not be refunded. THE DECISION OF THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL BE FINAL.

ENTRIES OUTSIDE OF ARIZONA:

All entries from out of state must have a Permit before entering Arizona. Obtain Health Certificate prior to requesting State Permit. Permits can be obtained from:

OVERNIGHT CAMPING/TRAILER PARKING:

HPEC has RV sites available for \$30 per night. Dry camping is available by reservation at \$10 per night. You may show out of your trailer, however, no temporary pens may be set up and no animals are allowed to stay overnight in trailers. If not reserving a stall, highly recommend reserving dry camp site so your trailer will be closer to the arena, otherwise, parking will be first come first serve. Exhibitors must park in north parking lot or overflow lot. Contact HPEC, 480-358-3793, directly to reserve and pay for your camp site.

STALL RENTALS:

Stalls are available to rent in the horse barn. Rates per stall: 1 night \$25, 2 nights \$40, 3 nights \$55. This includes \$10 cleaning fee. No outside bedding allowed; shavings must be purchased from HPEC at \$10 per bag. Minimum of one bag/stall is required. Contact HPEC to reserve and pay for stalls, 480-358-3793.

Class 15	1 year but under 2 years
Class 16	2 years but under 3 years
Class 17	3 years but under 5 years
Class 18	5 years and over
